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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 12.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Phase-1, District SAS Nagar.

The dispute is between the petitioner-accused and his complainant-brother as it is alleged that the petitioner has received by misrepresentation compensation for the entire land by GMADA to the extent of 1/5th share belonging to the complainant. On the previous date the learned Counsel for the petitioner had undertaken to pay the amount equivalent to the 1/5<sup>th</sup> share along with some interest of 12 lacs received from GMADA.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner has handed over two drafts for a sum of Rs.2,80,000/- to the investigating officer, which have been received by the complainant in the presence of the IO who are present in Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pritpal Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 25.08.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
