Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Chamkaur Singh son of Gurjant Singh, resident of village Vairoke, Tehsil Baghapurana, District Moga, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 61(1) of the Excise Act, in a case arising out of FIR No. 62, dated 3.7.2015, registered at Police Station, Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh of Police Station, Mehna, District Moga, submits that

in compliance of the interim directions dated 31.7.2015, issued by this Court, the petitioner did join the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed. The interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 31.7.2015 are made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.
