Report dated 23.1.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur has been received after recording statements of complainant Paramjit Singh as well as accused persons and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and to bring about personal harmony and more-so the offences for which the accused have been booked are not of very serious nature and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 2 dated 15.1.2015 registered at Police Station Mantiana, District Hoshiarpur under sections 452, 323, 34 IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
