INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.135 dated 18.09.2014, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 415, 417, 420, 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per FIR, the complainant leased first floor of the building to petitioner Tarundeep Kaur Sachdeva, owner of Fusion Infra Built India Ltd. The complainant has also stated in the application given to police that the said firm has not paid the rent of about two months nor paid the electricity bill amounting to Rs.5,000/-. It is also in the FIR that the said firm has also not paid the salary to its employees. Otherwise, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation nor anything is to be recovered from her. The offences are triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.01.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
