Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 23.04.2015, under Sections 420 and 419 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

As per the allegations, the complainant-Darshan Singh had paid a sum of ₹2,28,000/- to the petitioner for securing a job in the Forest Department, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations are vague and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Karam Singh, submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.08.2015, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 14.08.2015 is made absolute.
