Petitioner is a lady who seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Bhupinder Kaur alleging that a sum of Rs.45 lacs has been paid by her to Jagtar Singh with a promise that son of the complainant would be sent to abroad on the marriage basis with an NRI girl of Canada.

The FIR was registered against six persons. The husband of the petitioner has expired.

In view of vague allegations against the petitioner and petitioner having already joined investigation, petition is allowed. Order dated 13.08.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
