Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of orders dated 14.7.2014 and 24.3.2015 (Annexures P3 and P-4) on the ground that respondents no.4 to 7 have not been summoned to face trial in complaint No.68 of 2009 dated 15.10.2009 under Sections 323, 379, 504, 452, 506, 34 IPC and respondents no.2 and 3 have also not been summoned under Sections 504, 452, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact all the accused were required to be summoned for commission of offences, as mentioned in the complaint, whereas the trial Court has

summoned the accused no.2 and 3 only and that too, under Sections 323, 379, 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC. Therefore, the order passed by the trial Court dated 14.7.2014 (Annexure P3) and order dated 24.3.2015 (Annexure P4) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, in revision, are liable to be set aside.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The trial Court as well as the revisionary Court have considered the evidence on record including the statements of the complainant witnesses CW1, CW2 and CW3 and on the basis of the aforesaid statements, accused-respondents no.2 and 3 have been summoned under Sections 323, 379, 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and the remaining accused-respondents have not been summoned.

As per the records, *prima facie* case under Sections 323, 379, 506, 34 IPC is made out against accused-respondents no.1 and 2 only and therefore, no interference is warranted in the orders passed by the Courts below.

Dismissed.
