This is the third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.274, dated 13.07.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 341 and 302 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that earlier two petitions for grant of regular bail to the present petitioner were withdrawn on the ground of some defect in the translation of the FIR.

However, a perusal of the file shows that these petitions were withdrawn after arguing for some time as this Court was not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Regarding fresh ground, it is stated that Dharmesh, who was attributed injuries on the back of the deceased has been granted bail.

However, learned counsel for the State has informed that Dharmesh was a juvenile offender, therefore, he was granted bail in the present case.

No fresh ground is made out for grant of regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
