LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 4 dated 14.02.2014 registered under Sections 7, 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act and Sections 201, 221 and 120-B IPC at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau (H), Gurgaon.

It is contended that the complainant – Mohd. Ayub is an accused in FIR No. 471 dated 13.07.2013 registered under Sections 379, 188, 120B IPC. The petitioner was the investigating officer in the said case. Allegations of demand of bribe by the complainant are clearly motivated and false. No recovery was effected from the petitioner. In pursuance to order dated 30.07.2014, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Davender Singh, submits that the petitioner has indeed joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

In view of above said facts and circumstances, order dated 30.07.2014 is made absolute without commenting on the merits of the case.

The present petition is, accordingly, allowed.
