AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed in case bearing FIR No. 92 dated 28.06.2015, under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Ludhiana.

On 22.09.2015 the following order was passed:-

“At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the main accused is Amit Saini; the petitioners are his sister and brother respectively and they would ensure that Amit Saini would surrender but for that purpose the interim bail should be granted to them.

Learned Additional Advocate General as well as the learned counsel for the complainant have stated that they would not oppose this but much time should not be granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has very fairly prays for two weeks' time.

Adjourned to 06.10.2015.

In the meantime, arrest of the petitioners shall remain stayed.”

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioners and accepted by learned counsel for the respondent that the main accused Amit Saini has surrendered on 01.10.2015.

In these circumstances the petition is allowed. Let the petitioners appear before the investigating officer on 08.10.2015 between 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. and on any other date on which their appearance is so required by the investigating officer. On his appearance the investigating officer shall release them on anticipatory bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
