Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.180 dated 29.09.2013, registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 406, 409, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Interim order was passed in view of the age of the petitioner.

Petitioner-Baldev Singh Ahluwalia has filed affidavit which is taken on

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record. In the affidavit, it is mentioned that resolutions inducting other Directors from 1992 to 2014 are not with him.

It is the case of prosecution that it has enquired into from the Company Law Board with regard to the adding of new Directors and it has transpired that these resolutions were never produced before the authorities and on fake documents the Directors were made. The petitioner appears to be a beneficiary.

To blow the lid off fraud allegedly played by the petitioner, his custodial interrogation is necessary. In view of above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

It goes without saying that interim order stands vacated.
