LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 20 dated 18.02.2014 registered under Sections 365, 366-A, 376, 506 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdarshan Singh, informs that all prosecution witnesses except one, have been examined and the matter is fixed before the trial Court on 02.02.2015. Therefore, the trial is likely to conclude in the near future.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the petitioner is suffering from Kidney problem and needs specialized treatment. However, it is fairly conceded that the petitioner was given treatment and was also admitted to the Government Hospital, Amritsar while in custody.

I do not find it just and expedient to extend the benefit of bail pending trial at this stage when the trial is at a penultimate stage. It is, however, made clear that proper treatment as may be required would be given to the petitioner.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
