Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Smt. Mukesh Devi & Smt. Rati in case FIR No.309 dated 16.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Both the petitioners along with respective husbands and another couple (totaling six) have been accused of inflicting injuries on the complainant party.

As per allegations petitioner no.1 inflicted injury on the left shoulder of one Munesh with Iron Rod and the petitioner no.2 is alleged to have inflicted a *danda* blow on the leg of the complainant.

It is contended that both the injuries have been opined to be

simple in nature and the respective husbands of the petitioners were arrested and now been released on bail.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 03.08.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
