Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.75 dated 26.11.2013 under Sections 498A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted. Thereafter, efforts made for amicable settlement failed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the above and leaving the scope of an amicable settlement between the parties open, instant petition is allowed. Order dated 30.07.2014 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
