MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 478 dated 5.12.2014 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 506 IPC and 307 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurgaon

According to the allegations the petitioner alongwith several other persons caused injuries to three persons namely Bejinder, Tara Chand and Sukhbir by sticks. The reason for the fight was obscene and unsolicited advances and calls made by Bijender s/o Bhim Singh to the cousin of the victims.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even though the petitioner has been named in the FIR yet no specific role has been assigned to him. Besides the offence under Section 307 IPC which was initially added has been deleted from the array of offences. It is thus contended that the possibility of the petitioner's false implication cannot be

ruled out given the background of the dispute.

Learned counsel for the respondents on the other hand on instructions from ASI Ravi Dutt states that investigation is complete and the co-accused of the petitioner who was attributed the primary role has since been released on regular bail.

On due consideration of the matter I am of the opinion that the a perusal of the FIR would not reveal any specific role to the petitioner and thus finding that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on pre-arrest bail subject to his complying with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
