This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 394 dated 18.12.2012, under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station City Tarn Taran.

The petitioner was earlier on bail, but was absent on 18.02.2015, on which date he was required to appear as the case was fixed for 17.02.2015 which was declared holiday. His bail was cancelled and warrant of arrest was ordered to be issued.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that it was the only absence of the petitioner which was not willful. Otherwise, the matter stands compromised as the petitioner and Manpreet Kaur, alleged victim, are married and living together. Petition for quashing the FIR stands filed in this Court.

In view of the facts mentioned above and the fact that the petitioner has already suffered enough for his single absence as he is in custody since 05.05.2015, the request of the petitioner for bail is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
