Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 31.7.2014 under Sections 420 (later on added 467,468,471,120-B IPC), registered at P.S Rajasansi, Amritsar.

As per the allegations, the petitioner is stated to have introduced the complainant with the main accused-Lakhvir Singh for arranging a permanent Visa for going to Canada. They are alleged to have received Rs.17 lacs and have furnished a fake Visa for Canada.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that as far as the petitioner is concerned, he has returned his share of money and, therefore there is a settlement qua him with the complainant.

Learned state counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh,

concedes that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim bail/protection granted vide order dated 04.02.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.
