This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in a case registered under Sections 302/34/120-B IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station, Naraingarh, District Ambala vide FIR No. 287 dated 4.10.2013.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that out of 19 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 18 have been examined. Trial is likely to culminate soon.

Under the circumstances as the trial is at its fag end, there is no ground to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Dismissed.

Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to file afresh in case trial does not conclude within a period of 2 months.
