Petitioner allegedly appeared as impersonator for Purshottam Lal to help transfer of the property of Purshottam Lal in favour of Pawan Kumar at the instance of Harmesh Kumar driver of Pawan Kumar.

On the instructions of ASI Nirmal Singh, it has been informed that main accused Harmesh Kumar and Pawan Kumar have not yet been arrested.

Petitioner admits his participation but claims that he had been used by Harmesh Kumar the main accused. He had filed a petition for protection of his life and liberty before this Court. Petitioner is ready to furnish a statement relinquishing any right, title and interest in the property which had allegedly been transferred by his fraudulent appearance before the Sub-Registrar.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 12.05.2015 and the main accused having not been arrested,

he can be allowed concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will furnish an affidavit before the Sub-Registrar that the sale deed got executed from him can be cancelled by the Sub-Registrar being a fraudulent transaction.
