ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 123 dated 12.11.2014 registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga under Sections 306/34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is wife of the deceased. He further contends that the deceased was suffering from Diarrhoea and was admitted in a hospital and after his discharge on 05.11.2014 he was taken away by his family and he died 5 days later and the cause of death is not known till now. He further contends that parents of the petitioner had been allowed bail.

Challan has been presented. The allegations against the petitioner and her parents are that quarrel had taken place on 04.11.2014 between the deceased and the petitioner. The allegations are that the petitioner and her parents had administered poison to the husband. The viscera report has still not been received. The cause of death is not known.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take long time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
