Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.121 dated 22.6.2015, under Sections 420, 447, 448, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana City (Annexure P-1).

This Court vide order dated 4.8.2015, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Harbhajan Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 4.8.2015 are made absolute.
