

**Sukhdev Singh and anr. Vs. Parmod Kumar and ors.**

(Appeal against the Award dated 6.12.2001 passed by Shri A.K.Singla, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala, in Claim Petition No.210 of 6.4.99).

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹1,50,000/- (₹ One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. Two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount before the MACT, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1 – Sukhdev Singh, by the Insurance Company/Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. Appellant No.1 may furnish bank account particulars with IFS Code to the Insurance Company/MACT.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
