JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner/accused-Jaswinder Singh is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.125 dated 27.06.2015 under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**).

The share of the petitioner was included for sale in the agreement to sell dated 25.09.2007 executed by the wife of the petitioner without authorization. A sum of ₹ 5,35,000/- out of the total sale consideration of ₹ 13 Lacs stands paid and *ex parte* decree dated 05.04.2013 for sale of the half share of the minor son also stands passed and the execution is stated to be pending.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused had argued that his client was not in India when his alleged signatures on the agreement to sell dated 25.09.2007 executed between the complainant and wife of the petitioner, namely,

Daljit Kaur were affixed. He further submits that after the grant of interim protection

by this Court, vide order dated 10.08.2015, the petitioner/accused has since joined the investigations.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 10.08.2015, is made absolute.
