Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Dablu Sahni alleging that while driving a vehicle containing 128 godrej refrigerators, he was stopped by three boys in Santro car. He was tied and container was taken away at gun point. Later on, complainant was dropped on the road and his valuables were also taken away. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of his disclosure statement leading to recovery of one refrigerator and a pistol.

Co-accused of the petitioner, in the similar circumstances, has been granted the concession of bail. The complainant Dablu Sahni has expired.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. January 7, 2013. The petitioner was allegedly found in possession of one refrigerator which constituted part of the property snatched. Adopting the principle of parity, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner and nature of the evidence available; co-accused having been granted the concession of bail, petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds for a sum of Rs. 1 lac with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of trial Court.
