Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 10, dated 06.06.2015, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI, District Amritsar.

There are serious allegations to the effect that Harinder Singh, brother of the complainant, got a sale deed executed in his favour by producing the petitioner as Parminder Kaur before Sub Registrar. Thus, the petitioner impersonated as complainant Parminder Kaur and facilitated the execution of forged sale deed.

In view of this, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.
