Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.103 dated 12.07.2015, under Sections 420, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dyalpura, District Bathinda.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.08.2015:-

“This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.103 dated 12.07.2015 registered under Sections 420/34 IPC at Police Station Dyalpura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that earlier also complainant moved an application for registration of case on identical facts. The said matter was enquired into by the authorities, however, no FIR was registered. Thereafter, petitioner No.2 filed a

civil suit against the complainant. As a result of which present FIR has been got registered by the complainant. The allegations of sending the persons abroad relate to September, 2011.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab for 10.9.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall, however, join investigation as and when called for and they will also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Balwant Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 03.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
