This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 6, parents and uncle of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by petitioner No.1. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 02.04.1991(declared) as per copy of Acknowledgment/Enrollment Slip for Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2 is 12.08.1994 as per copy of Voter Identity Card (Annexure P-2). They got married on 30.07.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-4.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on the validity of marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to

respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
