Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 7 who are constantly threatening her to withdraw FIR No. 292 dated 20.06.2015, under Sections 356/376D/344/506 IPC, Police Station Sector-55, Faridabad, registered against respondents No. 5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has got registered the above-stated FIR against private respondents No. 5 to 7. It is further contended that there is constant pressure upon her for compromise.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG, Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the nature of order that is proposed to be passed, no reply is required to be filed by the respondents.

The petitioner has already filed representations dated 22.06.2015 and 26.06.2015 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively) in this regard before respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, to look into the representations dated 22.06.2015 and 26.06.2015 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively) and take care of the steps if warranted, with regard to protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.
