Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 25.5.2015, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tarn Taran, whereby on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. filed by the prosecution, the petitioner has been ordered to be summoned to face the trial under Sections 326, 323 and 148 IPC.

Since against the summoning order passed by the Magistrate, the remedies lies with the Sessions Court by way of revision, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition to avail the remedy of revision before the Sessions Court, available under the law.
