Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking appropriate directions against the respondents to register FIR against the accused, in view of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Lalita Kumari v. Government of UP and others, 2013 (4) RCR (Crl.) 979.**

Notice of motion was issued.

During the pendency of this petition, CRM-35493-2014 was filed by one Gautam Cheema praying for initiating criminal contempt of court proceedings against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Jagir Singh, ASI Shamsher Singh and HC Krishan, Police Station Phase-II, SAS Nagar (Mohali), submits that since during the pendency of the present petition, FIR has been registered, it has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such. However, learned counsel for the applicant in CRM-35493-2014 submits that let the instant petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous but liberty may be granted to the applicant to pursue his remedy against the petitioner, as and when necessity arises, by resorting to appropriate process of law.

In view of the above-said statements made by the learned counsel for the parties, instant petition stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, however, with liberty to the applicant of CRM-35493-2014, as prayed for.
