It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the girl i.e. the victim had not supported the prosecution version before the trial Court. The matter is now at the final stage.

It will not be in the interest of justice to consider quashing of the FIR in view of the offences under Sections 366 and 376 IPC, though those were added later on.

However the trial Court shall obviously pass a judgment in the matter considering the evidence brought before it.
