This order will dispose of two petitions bearing CRM-M 25655 and M-25657 of 2015 for grant of interim temporary bail for 15 days to the petitioner on medical grounds in FIR No.85 dated March 21, 2015 and FIR No.261 dated August 16, 2014. The petition is not supported by sufficient material to indicate any serious ailment to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner seeks to get himself treated in private hospital as such he should be granted interim temporary bail.

I have carefully gone through the entire petitions which have been filed touching the merits of the case claiming that the matter has been compromised by settling the accounts with the aggrieved persons.

After hearing counsel for the petitioner and going through the record, I do not find any reasonable cause to grant interim temporary bail to the petitioner especially when there is allegation of fraud having been played against thousands of investors who have come present in different groups to oppose the petitions. 29 aggrieved persons have been represented through

Ms.Promila Nain, out of which 19 persons are allottees and 10 persons are non-allottees. Mr. Yogesh Gupta, Advocate represents 16 unallottee investors, Mr. Parvesh Saini represents 8 non-allottees, Mr. Randhawa represented 35 aggrieved persons who are allottees and non-allottees. Mr.Manoj Bajaj appeared for 9 aggrieved persons, Mr. Sumit Goel had put in appearance for 52 aggrieved persons, Mr. J.S. Ghuman, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of 6 unallotted investors. Sh. Ganesh Kamat represented 23 persons which include 9 allottees and 14 unallottees. Mr. Satish Aggarwal, Advocate represented 75 persons of Cosmo City Flat Buyers Welfare Society and Mr. Ish Puneet Singh, Advocate represented 4 allottee persons.

After going through the circumstances of the case, I do not find any ground to grant the interim temporary bail to the petitioner on medical ground at this stage.

Dismissed.
