Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Sarabjit Singh in case bearing FIR No.285 dated 02.12.2013 for offences punishable under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered with Police Station City, District Kapurthala on medical grounds.

As per allegations the petitioners was found in possession of 240 grams intoxicating powder and on report of chemical examiner, the quantity of contraband was opined to be of commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been diagnosed of suffering from HIV Positive and his condition is deteriorating, therefore, the prayer for grant of bail on medical grounds.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from HC Gian Singh states that from the documents placed on record, it nowhere shows that the

physical condition of the petitioner is deteriorating, apart from the fact that the entire prosecution evidence is over.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
