The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.215 dated 26.09.2014, under Section 409 of IPC, registered with Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

It is contended that the petitioner/accused-HC Sanjeev Kumar was arrested on 27.09.2014 and in view of the possibility of the trial been protected, prayer for bail has been made.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagga Singh, states that after framing of the charges, the case is fixed for evidence of the prosecution witnesses for 12.08.2015, and in view of the gravity of the charges, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

It is apparent that the allegation is that the petitioner/accused-HC Sanjeev Kumar while working as the Munshi Head Constable of the Police Station

had misappropriated a sum of ₹ 5,40,000/- approximately, gold ornaments, weapons, gas cylinder etc., which during investigation, were got recovered from his quarter within the police compound.

The nature of the charges and keeping in view the duty assigned to the petitioner, a member of the disciplined force, no indulgence is required to be shown to the petitioner.

In view of the seriousness of the nature of allegations against the petitioner, no ground is made out to extend the concession of regular bail.

Dismissed.
