1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court received that the parties have entered into a compromise. In terms of the compromise, cheque No. 137417 dated 16.1.2015, for an amount of Rs. 4,37,500/-, in favour of Krishma Anand (respondent No. 2), drawn on Bank of Baroda, has been handed over to the learned counsel for respondent No. 2. Both the parties are agreed to abide by the terms of the compromise.

In terms of the compromise, the present petition is allowed. Consequently, FIR No. 5 dated 29.3.2014, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station NRI PS, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, qua the present petitioners, stand quashed. However, if the said cheque bounces, the private respondent shall always be at liberty to move this Court for reviving the present petition.
