JASPAL SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No.4 and 5 and further not to register any criminal case against the petitioners.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that so far as relief of issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 not to register any criminal case against petitioners, is concerned, same is withdrawn, at this stage.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, AAG,

Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Nawanshehar), to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated August 01, 2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
