LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 46 dated 23.05.2014 registered under Sections 406, 498A, 34 IPC at Police Station Mehtiana District Hoshiarpur.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre to explore the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties. As per the report of the Mediator, the parties have settled their dispute in an amicable manner and have arrived at a mutual settlement. The terms and conditions of the settlement are attached along with the Mediator's report.

Learned counsel for the complainant affirms that the matter has indeed been settled amicably.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Lakhvinder Kumar, affirms and verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Order dated 01.08.2014 is made absolute.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner does not honour the terms and conditions of the settlement, the complainant shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application.
