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SURINDER GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

 This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of private respondents, i.e. parents of petitioner No.1.

 Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by petitioner No.1. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1-Rajni Sharma is 16.09.1992 as per copy of certificate of Middle Standard Examination (Annexure P-1) and of petitioner No.2-Atul Sharma is 26.11.1990 as per the copy of certificate of Matriculation Examination (Annexure P-2). They got married on 31.07.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-4.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the validity of marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) (addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order along with copy of the representation.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
