 This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 07 dated 12.04.2011 under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station D-Division, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

 Report has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready with the demand draft of ₹ 50,000/- and FDR in the name of minor for a sum of ₹ 2 lacs as per terms and conditions of compromise.

 So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as “**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**” 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR stands

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quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stands quashed.

The said documents i.e. demand draft and FDR be deposited with the Registry of this Court with a notice to the complainant to collect those documents. Receipt of the Registry be filed within ten days.
