RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners No.1 & 3 seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.26 dated 21.03.2015 under Sections 324, 323, 451, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station City Batala.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sawinder Singh, Police Station City Batala, submits that in compliance of the orders passed by this Court, petitioners No.1 & 3 have joined the investigation and they are no more required for the purpose of any further investigation. However, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the instant petition, contending that petitioner No.1 is not appearing before the learned trial Court in criminal trial arising out of FIR No.35 dated 08.02.2005, registered at Police Station City Batala.

Be that as it may, since the petitioners No.1 & 3 have joined the investigation and there is no allegation against them that they have tried to misuse the concession of interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 05.08.2015 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute qua petitioner No.1 Krishan Baldev Suri and petitioner No.3 Rahul Suri, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
