This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.60 dated 22.05.2015 under Sections 407/120-B IPC at Police Station G.R.P. Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he in connivance of co-accused pilfered certain chemical from the containers to be sent from Gujarat to Pakistan.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sham Sunder submits that though investigation is still pending, admittedly, recovery has been effected.

Under the circumstances, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
