Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in complaint No.25 dated 20.10.2011 under Sections 406, 418, 420, 120-B and 34 IPC pending before the learned SDJM, Phul.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that earlier the petitioners had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing. However, because of some communication gap, they could not appear before the learned trial Court under the impression that since they moved an application for exemption, they were not required to appear. This was the reason that bail bonds of the petitioners were cancelled. He further submits that petitioners are ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court which may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioners, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, learned SDJM, Phul, is directed that if the petitioners surrender on or before the date already fixed before him, i.e. 11.8.2015, bail application of the petitioners shall be considered, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, by passing an appropriate order at an early date.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant petition stands disposed of.
