Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. on behalf of husband of the complainant in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 03.06.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur (**Annexure P-1**).

The mediation proceedings before this Court were successful and a written settlement deed was drawn on 30.11.2015, which is available at **Mark A**.

Learned Counsel for the parties, on instructions from their respective Clients, are agreed that for a loss of the Gold Jewellery item, in terms of Clause (d) of Para 7 of the written deed, the husband has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.45,000/- at the time of recording of statement at first motion in the divorce proceedings by mutual consent to be filed by the parties.

At the time of hearing, a sum of Rs.1 Lac in terms of the written deed by way of demand draft have been paid by learned Counsel for the petitioner and

accepted on behalf of the complainant-Preeti by her father-Prem Nath Aneja, who is present in the Court today. Photocopy of the same has been retained for the purpose of record.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 06.08.2015, is made absolute.
