Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 134, dated 14.06.2015, for offence punishable under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

This Court, vide order dated 06.08.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 06.08.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

On the other hand, Mr. IPS Mangat, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant submit that the petitioner has been named in the suicide note. So far as the delay of two years in filing the FIR, the same is because of the influence of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Mohd. Rasheed, also submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 06.08.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
