Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.36  
dated 19.3.2015 under Section 420 IPC, PS Daresi, Ludhiana,  
Distt.Ludhiana.

As per allegations, petitioner was working as Salesman  
with M/s PK Knitwear. He by introducing one Kunal as proprietor of  
M/s Ponahari Traders secured a purchase transaction of goods worth  
Rs.2.90 lacs. On investigation, the said firm as also alleged Kunal were  
found to be non-existent.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhvinder  
Singh states that although the petitioner has joined investigation he has  
not submitted any documents to prove the existence of M/s Ponahari
