Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking appropriate direction to the official respondents to ensure protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.9 to 13.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No.3, Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna-respondent No.4 as well as Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa-respondent No.5, but no action was taken. Thereafter, the petitioners approached the Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No.2 by their self-contained representation dated 24.7.2015 (Annexure P-3) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide their representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No.2, is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners including threat perception raised in their representation dated 24.7.2015 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
