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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.23 dated 07.05.2014, registered under Sections 406/420 IPC, Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 27.08.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated. He further states that the matter has been compromised and the complaint filed against the petitioner under the Negotiable Instruments Act has been withdrawn. In this regard he has placed on record copy of order dated 21.08.2015.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.08.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
