This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.12 (Annexure P-1) dated 09.08.2013, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, at Police Station S.A.S. Nagar, District Mohali, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 26.08.2014, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Bassi, dated 22.08.2014, has been received, wherein it has been noticed that

the compromise appears to be genuine, without any pressure, coercion and same has been done with the free consent of the parties.

Hence, in view of the above and the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and in "*Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*" (2014) 6 SCC 466, by which, the High Courts are directed to give adequate treatment to the settlement between the parties and in exercise of its power under Section 482 for quashing, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

The petitioners undertakes to transfer the Activa scooter in the name of the daughter of complainant, namely, Tannu Goyal.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.12 (Annexure P-1) dated 09.08.2013, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, at Police Station S.A.S. Nagar, District Mohali, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
