This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 122 dated 15.7.2012 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P1) along with consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 30.6.2014 (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant Sunil Kumar, Geena Kumari and Ajay Kumar as well as that of accused and reported that the the parties have entered into compromise which seems to be genuine, voluntarily and without any influence and coercion.

Since the matter has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No. 122 dated 15.7.2012 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar City (Annexure P1) alongwith the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
