Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is complainant in case FIR No.133 dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran. Respondent No.4 along with others are accused in that FIR. They entered into the house of petitioner armed with weapons while following one Laddu Sahnsi son of Khushia Ram. On being objected, respondent No.4 and others inflicted injuries to petitioner and thereafter, ran away from the house. Petitioner has filed representation dated 21.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Varun Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing reply.

Respondent No.2 can be asked to have fair look on the representation of petitioner (Annexure P-2). Respondent No.2 would devise his own means to extract truth from the claim of petitioner and in case the representation of petitioner is found to have some substance, then respondent No.2 would take all remedial steps in order to protect life, liberty and property of petitioner.
